Spring Wildflower Pilgrimage



Saturday, April 6

- 9:00am **Wildflower Hike to Hemlock Falls** - *(Registration Required)* Meet at the Nature Center parking lot at 9:00am to drive to the Prater Place Trail Head and enjoy one of our lesser-known trails. This 6-mile out and back hike features a small but beautiful waterfall, Hemlock Falls, and is full of unique topography and wildflowers. Please dress for the weather and wear appropriate hiking shoes. A creek crossing is possible as well. There is a fee of \$10. Register online by clicking the Upcoming Events tab on the Fall Creek Falls State Park website or visit the Nature Center for assistance. No refunds will be given for cash transactions or customer cancellations.
- 9:00am **Wildflower Ramble at Camps Branch and Crusher Hole** – Meet Ranger Cara at the Nature Center for a short drive to the Camps Branch and Crusher Hole areas. Carpooling is recommended. From there we will go on a leisurely walk to view the wildflowers in these 2 areas. Don't forget to bring your field guides.
- 10:00am **Wildflower Photography Seminar** – Meet local photographer Anthony Ladd at the Nature Center Parking Lot for a short drive to the Crusher Hole. Carpooling is recommended. While at this wildflower hotspot, Anthony will lead a hands-on photography session. The Crusher Hole area has an abundance of wildflowers so don't miss out on this photography session.
- 2:00pm **Wheeler Farm Excursion** – Meet Park Manager Jacob at the Nature Center Parking Lot for a short drive to the Wheeler Farm to view some spectacular geologic features and wildflowers. Carpooling is recommended. This will be a moderately strenuous 2-mile roundtrip hike to a natural bridge and small waterfall. Wear sturdy shoes or boots and bring along some water.

- 2:00pm **Ranger Led Wildflower Van tour** - *(Registration Required)* Meet Cara at the Nature Center Parking Lot to explore some of the best wildflower viewing areas on the park. Best of all, you don't have to burn your own gas or navigate winding roads! There is a fee of \$10.
