Each year, Fall Creek Falls State Park, in conjunction with the Friends of Fall Creek Falls State Park and the Tennessee Arts Commission, proudly presents a display of the Cumberland Plateau's rich cultural heritage. Traditions which have existed for many decades in the region are expertly demonstrated and performed.

The Mountaineer Folk Festival will take place in the Village Green Area. Official kick off will be Friday, September 9th, at 7 pm CST and will last until 10 pm CST. Saturday September 10th, the hours will be 9am until 10pm. Sunday, September 11th, the hours will be 9am until 5pm.

Fall Creek Falls State Park is in Van Buren and Bledsoe Counties, eleven miles east of Spencer and fifteen miles west of Pikeville. The park may be entered from Highway 111 or Highway 30. The objective of the Mountaineer Folk Festival is to support the development of arts and crafts in the state of Tennessee. Crafters may only sell original handmade items. All items must be handcrafted by the exhibitor. Mass production work, works made from commercial molds or patterns, items made largely from computer guided equipment, or objects composed largely of commercial mountings will be subject to the discretion of the craft jury.

To apply for display space, please fill out an application form. All crafts will be juried to determine eligibility.

- All applicants must provide three or more photographs of their craft along with a full description of the work being reviewed. A jury will determine the eligibility based on the photographs submitted. If you display items other than items in your photographs, the jury reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to remove any work it deems unsuitable. There is a non-refundable fee of \$50.00 per 10x10 booth space if paid by July 31, 2021, or \$75.00 per space after August 1, 2021.
- All applicants who wish to return to the booth space they occupied in the previous year must submit applications and payment with a postmark date of July 31st or earlier. New vendor booth spaces will be assigned based on space availability after July 31st. After the initial jury process, a letter will include setup times. There will be security on site; however, neither Fall Creek Fall State Park, the Tennessee Arts Commission, nor the Friends of Fall Creek Falls State Park shall be held liable in the event of theft, vandalism, damaged, and/or loss of property.
